Scheme of Examination & Standard of Passing for SEC and VBC

As per the decision of the concern Board of Studies or Competent Authority

- 1. A candidate who fails in any number of subjects during semester I & II shall admitted to B.Com. (**Business Studies**).-II (appear for semester– III & Semester IV examination)
- 2. However the candidate shall not be admitted to B.Com. (**Business Studies**)- III (Semester-V) unless he/she passed in all the subjects at B.Com. (**Business Studies**) I (Semester-I & Semester-II)
- 3. A candidate who fails in any number of subjects during Semester-III & IV shall be admitted for B.Com. (**Business Studies**).-III & allowed to appear for Semester –V & VI examinations.
- 4. However the candidate shall not be admitted to B.Com. (**Business Studies**)- IV (Semester-VII) unless he/she passed in all the subjects at B.Com. (**Business Studies**)
- 5. III (Semester-V& Semester-VI).
- 6. However under the National Education Policy the rules extended by KBP University, time to time regarding ATKT will be applicable.


